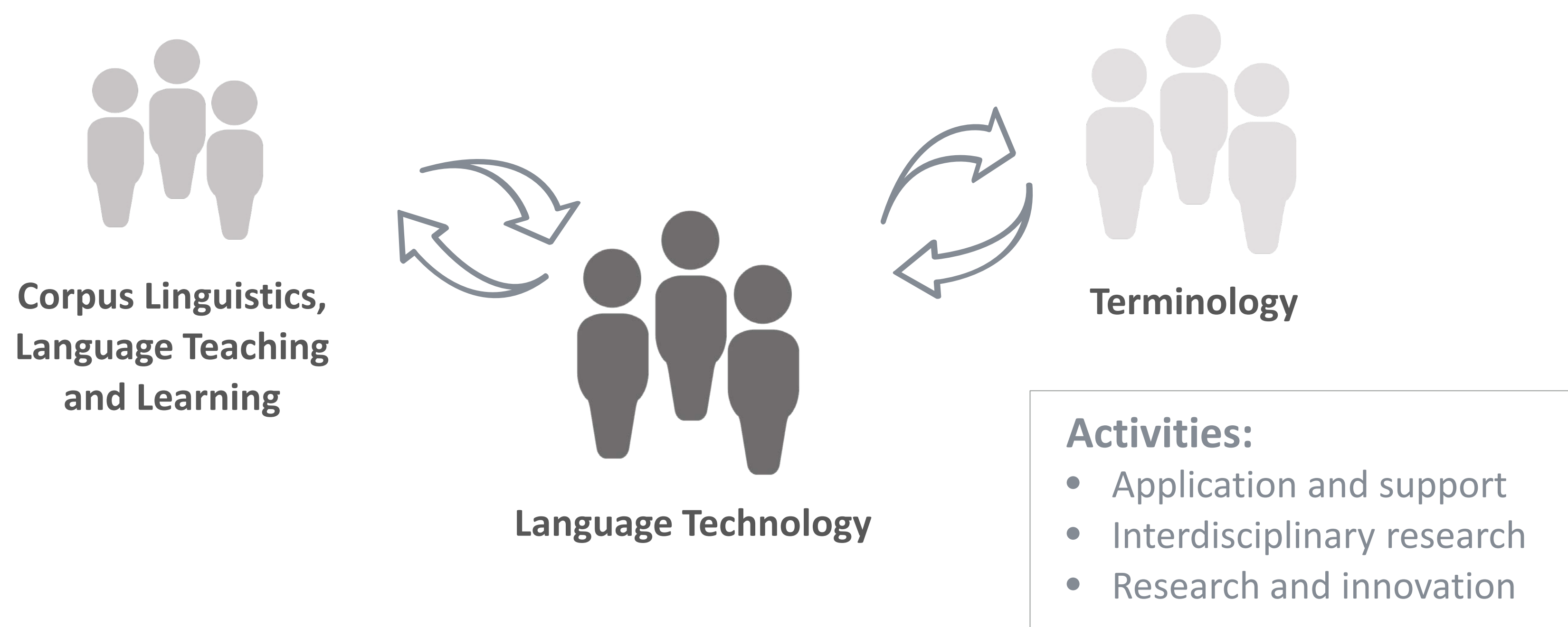
INSTITUTE FOR APPLIED LINGUISTICS & EURAC RESEARCH

LANGUAGE TECHNOLOGY GROUP

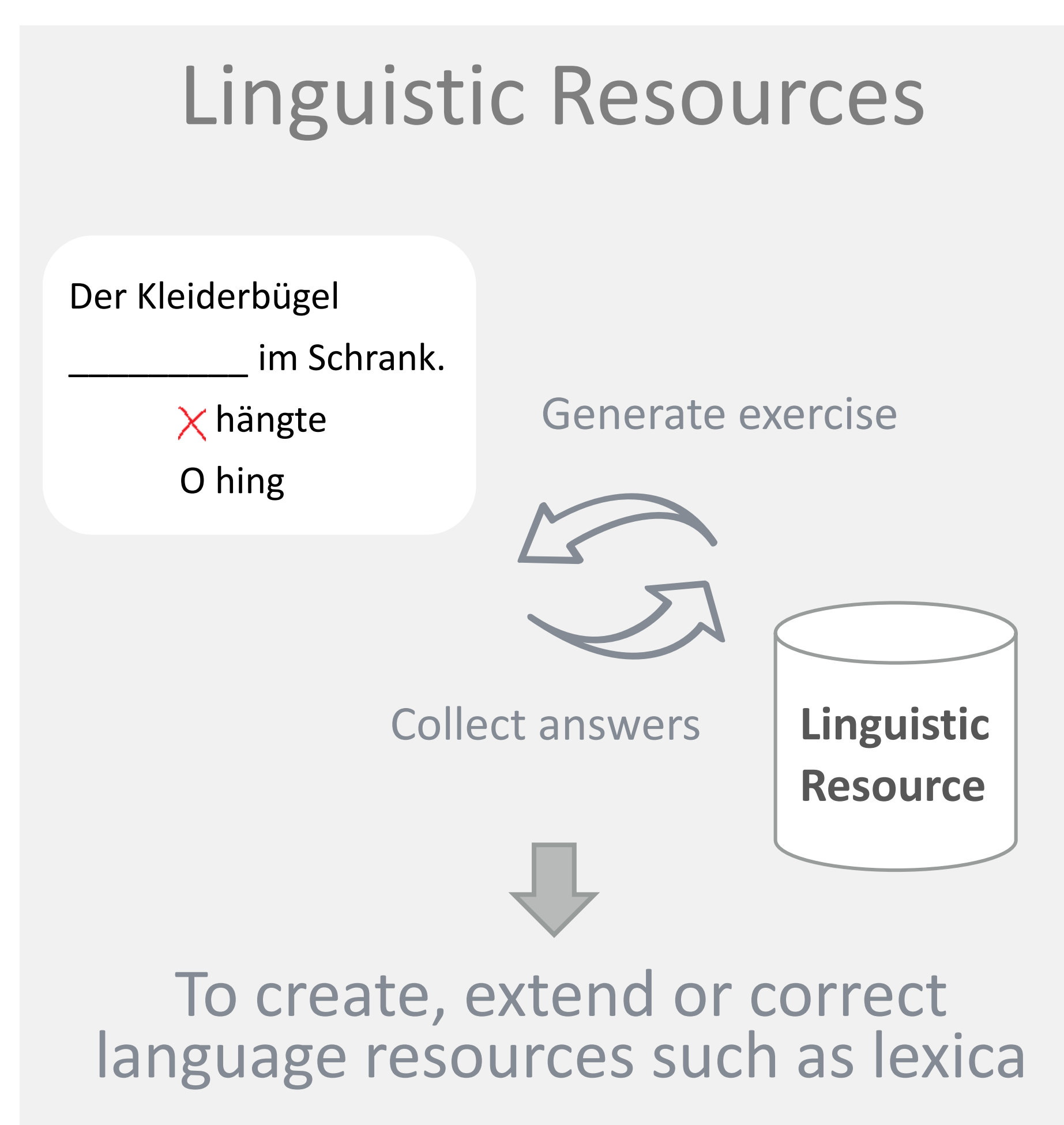
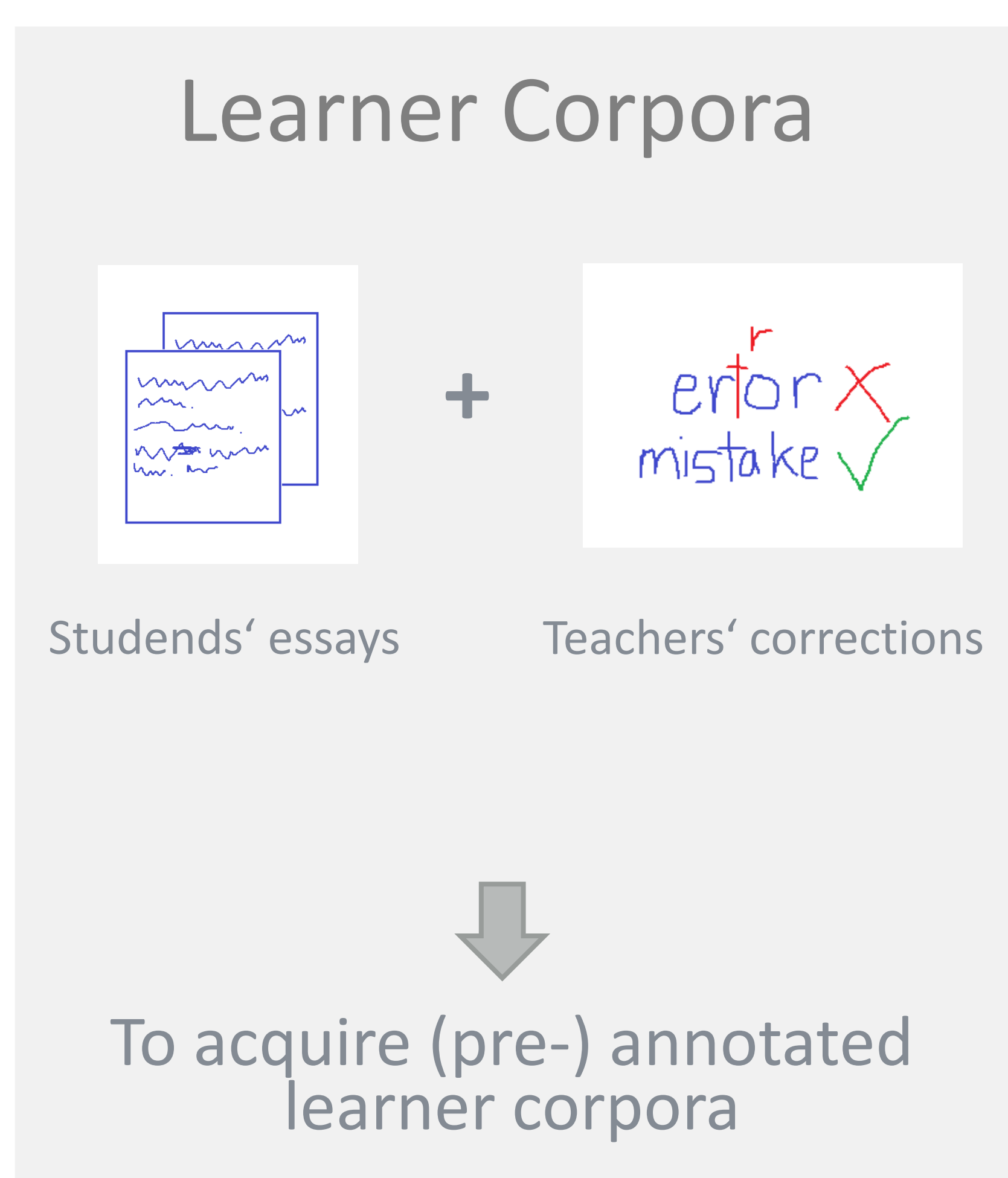
