Scientific report from the host for STMS, Elena Volodina, University of Gothenburg, Sweden

In the period of May, 26 - June, 1 Språkbanken hosted two events relevant to Iztok Kosem's visit:

- 1. Tutorial on automatic sentence selection for second language learners. Link to the tutorial program: https://sweclarin.se/swe/sentence-selection-tutorial
 Iztok Kosem participated in the tutorial during May, 29-30, among others giving a presentation at the mini-workshop on May, 29, and going through principles for sentence selection algorithms used at Språkbanken.
- 2. Shaping ideas on using crowdsourcing techniques for language learning. This event involved active discussions, knowledge and experience exchange, demostration of existing platforms and projects in Sweden (Språkbanken) and Slovenia, as well as brainstorming ideas on futher exploiting crowdsourcing for language learning research and practical teaching.

Besides, a number of meetings with other colleagues at Språkbaknken have been organized (Lars Borin, Dan Rosén).

Summary: the visit was very fruitful and productive, a lot of perspectives have been outlined for future collaboration in both areas mentioned above, exchange of information concerned not only the host and the applicant, but a wider group of people both working at Språkbanken, and people outside (e.g. an Estonian guest researcher).
