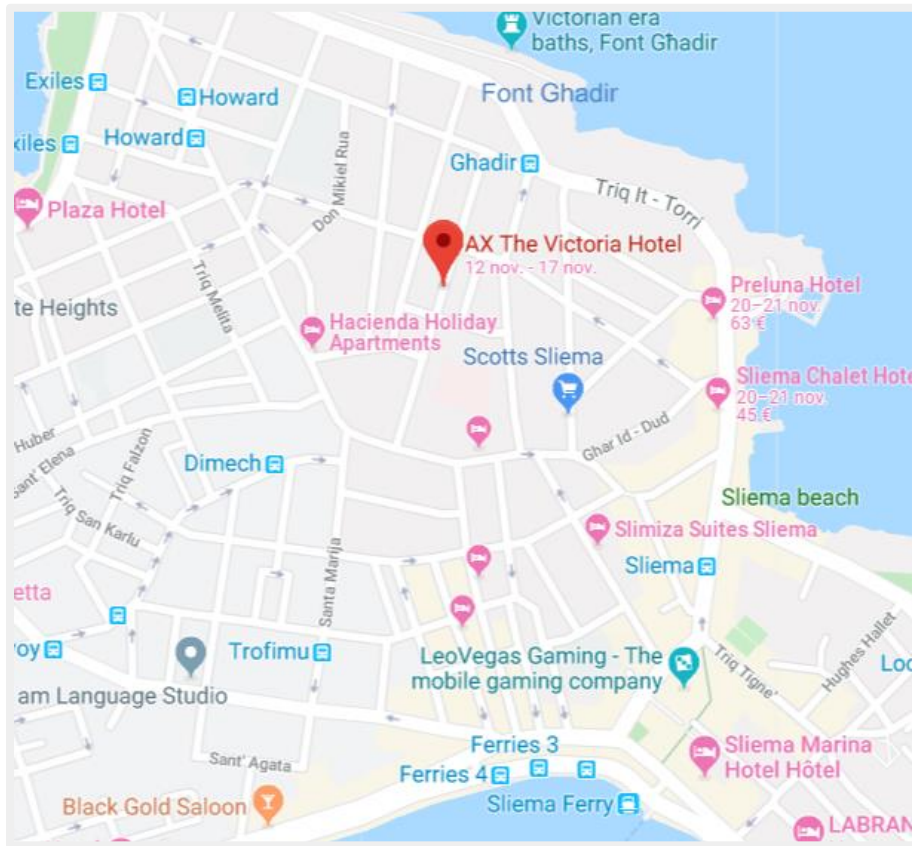

Registration
